Inclement Weather Plan

In case of inclement weather, GCAF will follow the operating schedule of the Georgia EPD Fulton county offices. If the EPD opens late or will be closed, the GCAF Kennesaw and Camp Creek offices, GCAF Service Centers and audit team will do the same.

If EPD/GCAF opens late or will be closed, inspector training classes will not be held. Individuals scheduled for training will be contacted by GCAF within five business days to reschedule.

Also, if EPD/GCAF opens late or will be closed, faxed credit card order for e-certs will not be processed during that time. GCAF encourages all station owners to utilize e-commerce for 24/7 access to their station accounting and e-cert orders. Information on how to get started with e-commerce is on the GCAF Web site or call GCAF Station Assistance. Faxed credit card orders received while GCAF is closed will be processed on the following operational business day, by end of day. As a reminder, maintain an ample supply of e-certs on your analyzer at all times.

EPD will post their weather closing schedule on WSB (TV and Web site), WSB 750 AM and WSB 98.5 FM.
