Station Certificate

As a reminder, all emission inspection stations must display the **original** GCAF Certified Emission Inspection Station Certificate (also known as "Certificate of Authorization"). Stations are not allowed to post photocopies of the certificate. Station owners/managers that want to have the certificate mailed to an address other than the station address are responsible for ensuring the **original** station certificate is delivered to the station and publicly displayed. Failure to do so may result in an audit failure.

Rule 391-3-20-.09(2)(m) states: "A public inspection station owner shall display the Certificate of Authorization issued to the inspection station pursuant to this Chapter at said inspection station in a convenient location visible to the public."

~ GCAF requires that you print, read, and store all GAS messages in a binder on or near the analyzer. GCAF also recommends that you print a second copy of these messages and post them in a prominent location for your employees to read. To retrieve and print a previous GAS message, go to the GAS message retrieval function in your analyzer and select the appropriate message to print (the analyzer holds up to 500 messages). ~
