"Refresh" to View New GCAF Website

To ensure that inspectors and motorists always receive the most recent forms and information posted at the GCAF website, it is important to refresh the website when accessing www.CleanAirForce.com. Many new and updated forms have been posted, including the new E-Cert Order Form.

Follow these steps each time you visit the GCAF website:

- Go to www.CleanAirForce.com.
- Select the "Refresh" button (which is usually at the top of screen in the toolbar and shows two green arrows). This is especially important if you have saved the web address in your favorites.

This process is not unique to the GCAF website. Most websites must be "refreshed" each time you visit in order to capture the most recent information posted.

To access the E-Cert Order Form and additional accounting forms, go to www.CleanAirForce.com and click on the Stations button. Then, click on Quick Links, E-Commerce and E-Cert Info, and scroll down to the bottom of the page to download the form.

Visit the GCAF website often! Updated versions of the following information and documents are posted to help make your job easier:

- E-commerce and station accounting information and forms
- Repair *Watch* Public Report
- Station applications and new station application packet
- Industry Advisory Board (IAB) meeting schedule and board members
- EPD rules
- Foreign language translations of I/M program information
