## I/M Program Updates for 2009

GCAF offers the following I/M program updates and reminders for the 2009 testing season:

- ✦ **For the 2009 testing season**, vehicles that require testing include **1985 - 2006** model year gasoline-powered cars and light duty trucks with a gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) of 8,500 pounds and less, registered in the 13 metro Atlanta counties. Model years 2007 and newer and model years 1984 and older are exempt.
- ✦ **The Repair Waiver amount will change to \$787.** This amount is based on the Consumer Price Index and is required to be adjusted annually.
- ✦ It is the seller's responsibility to sell a vehicle with a passing Vehicle Emission Inspection Report (VIR). To file a complaint against a seller, motorists may download a form titled "Used Vehicle Sale Complaint Form" at [www.CleanAirForce.com](http://www.CleanAirForce.com).
- ✦ Motorists can acquire a copy of their Georgia Vehicle Emission Inspection Report (VIR) online at [www.CleanAirForce.com](http://www.CleanAirForce.com) or at any GCAF Service Center free of charge.
- ✦ For your convenience, station owners have the opportunity to order e-certs and manage accounting 24 hours a day/seven days a week with e-commerce, the Online Certificate Requisition Program. - ✦ Make certain your state-certified sign is in compliance and in good condition. If your sign is rusted, faded or damaged, GCAF recommends purchasing a new one from an approved sign vendor. Details can be found on the GCAF Web site.
- ✦ Stations must post a "Closed" sign when testing cannot be performed during the station's posted operating hours. The "Closed" sign must be posted in a location that can be easily viewed by motorists from their vehicle. For assistance, contact GCAF Station Assistance.

Click on the station microsite for details on inspector training and Industry Advisory Board (IAB) meetings. There is a "Forms and Program Info" page where you can print PDF documents including the Emission Repair Form and the E-Cert Order Form for e-certs. From this page you can also print program information that has been translated into Spanish, Korean and Vietnamese (post in your waiting area or provide copies as needed to customers). Motorists and inspectors can send program questions and comments via e-mail from the GCAF Web site, by clicking on "Contact Us."
