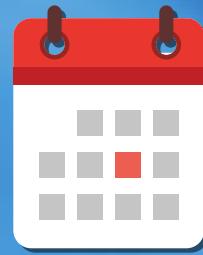


# 7 Surprising 2017 BACK-TO-SCHOOL STATISTICS

The average daily commute for motorists in metro Atlanta is 31 minutes, according to the U.S. Census Bureau

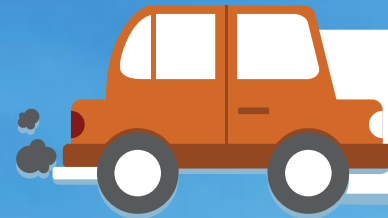
