

# 5 TIPS *to help* DRIVERS ACE THE EMISSIONS TEST

## 28-42 DAYS

Days prior to the registration renewal date for pre-emissions test vehicle preparation.

## 14 DAYS

Days a vehicle should be driven (city and highway) following check engine light reset.



## 1996 AND NEWER

Model year vehicles on which the check engine light may illuminate as a result of a loose fuel cap.



## 30 DAYS

Days from a failed test in which motorists may receive a free retest at the original testing station.

## SENIOR *Motorist Tip*

If you are 65 years of age or older, your vehicle is 10 model years old or older, you do not drive more than 5,000 miles per year and you are the primary registered vehicle owner, you may qualify for the Senior Exemption.
