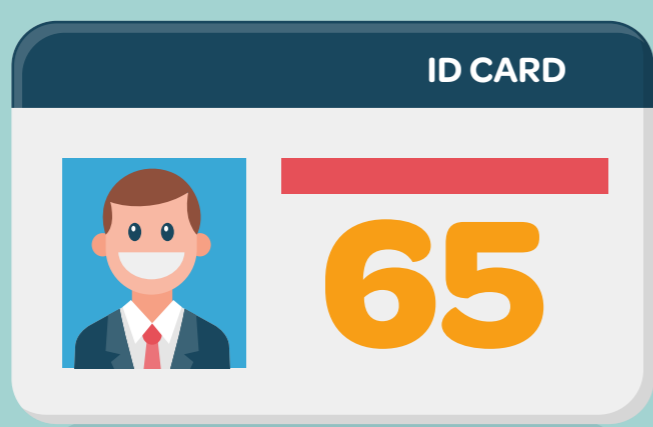


5 THINGS

YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT THE SENIOR EXEMPTION

Senior motorists 65 years of age or older are eligible to receive an exemption from Georgia's Vehicle Emissions Inspection & Maintenance (I/M) Program. However, there are five criteria that senior motorists must meet in order to be eligible for the Senior Exemption.

1



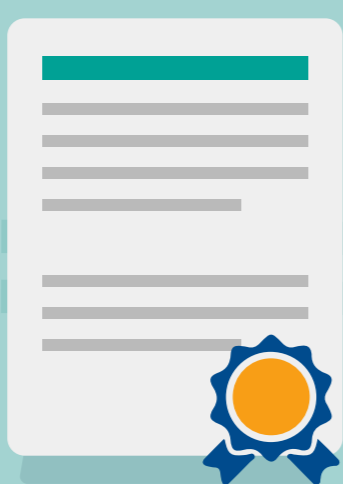
You must be 65 years of age or older at the time of the application.

You must be the primary registered vehicle owner (i.e. your name must be the first name listed on the vehicle title/registration).

Proof of ownership of the vehicle (current or previous year Georgia registration or renewal notice or the vehicle's Georgia title).

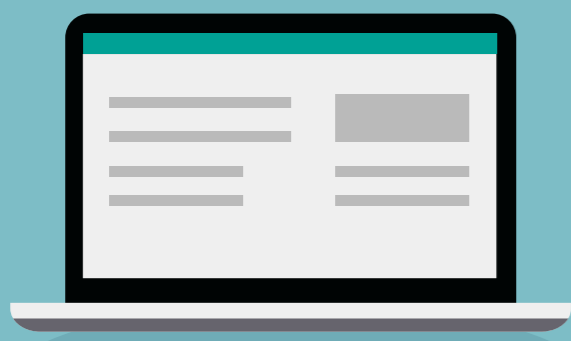
Your vehicle must be **10 model years old or older**. For 2019, this includes all 2009 and older model year vehicles.

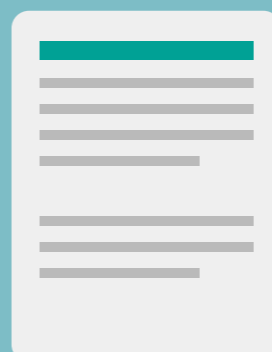
Annual mileage cannot exceed 5,000 miles per year and the odometer must be in functional order to demonstrate the "under 5,000 miles/year" requirement.

There are two ways to submit a Senior Exemption Application:

or



Required documents can be submitted in-person at any Georgia's Clean Air Force Customer Service Center or select metro Atlanta tag offices.

A proxy may submit the completed Senior Exemption Application and necessary documentation for eligible seniors, however if submitting by proxy, the application must be completed and signed by the proxy. The proxy must also submit a copy of his or her driver's license.
