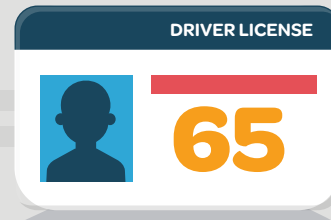

THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT THE SENIOR EXEMPTION

Adult motorists 65 years or older in the 13 metro Atlanta counties may be eligible to receive a Senior Exemption from Georgia's Vehicle Emissions Inspection & Maintenance (I/M) Program, but must meet five important requirements in order to qualify.

1



You must be **65 years or older.**

3



The annual mileage on the vehicle cannot exceed **5,000 miles**. Also, the odometer must be functional in order to demonstrate the under 5,000 miles per year requirement.

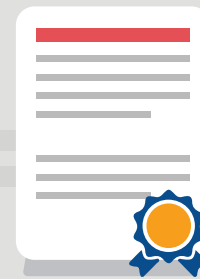
Your vehicle is **10 model years old or older**. For 2020, this includes all 2010 and older model year vehicles.

You are the **primary registered vehicle owner.**

5



You have **proof of vehicle ownership.**

DO YOU QUALIFY?

There are **TWO WAYS** to be considered for a senior exemption:

- 1) File an application electronically through www.cleanairforce.com.
- 2) Submit the required forms in-person at any Georgia's Clean Air Force Customer Service Center or at select metro Atlanta tag offices.

A proxy may turn in the application and necessary documentation for eligible seniors, but they must sign the paperwork and submit a copy of their driver's license.
