

Georgia's Clean Air Force Offers Exemption to Drivers 65+



Georgians aged 65 or older may not be aware, but Georgia's Clean Air Force, in partnership with the Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD), offers a senior exemption to the state's annual vehicle emissions testing requirement. However, drivers in the 13 metro counties must meet five requirements.



You do not drive the vehicle more than **5,000 miles** a year, and the odometer must display the mileage.



You are the **primary registered vehicle owner**.

DO YOU QUALIFY?

There are **TWO WAYS** to file for a senior exemption:

- 1)** File an application electronically through www.cleanairforce.com.
- 2)** Submit the required forms in-person at any Georgia's Clean Air Force Customer Service Center or at select metro Atlanta tag offices.*

A proxy may submit the application and necessary documentation for eligible seniors. If utilized, the proxy must sign the paperwork and provide a valid government issued I.D.
